The North Kawartha Public Library collection is selected in accordance with specific criteria to meet high standards in quality, content, expression and format.

Procedures

- 1. All acquisitions, whether purchased or donated, shall be considered in terms of the following criteria:
 - a. suitability of subject and style for the intended users;
 - b. reputation and authority of the author and publisher;
 - c. comments of reviewers, critics and publishers;
 - d. strengths and weaknesses of the existing collection;
 - e. demand in the community for a certain subject or title;
 - f. availability of materials through other libraries in the community or area;
 - g. suitability and quality of physical form, layout and construction;
 - h. timeliness and accuracy of the information contained therein;
 - i. purchase price and other budgetary considerations.
- Special emphasis shall be given to acquiring materials created by Canadians and materials about Canada.
- Suggestions from the public for the purchase of books or other materials, are welcome but must be considered in accordance with the Library's selection criteria.
- The CEO/Librarian must make all final decisions about the contents of the collection.
