Subject: Front Line Pumper Tender Results RFT-03-26

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### Recommendation:

That Council approve the purchase of a 2026 Front Line Pumper RFT-03-26 for the North Kawartha Emergency Services as tendered from City View Specialty Vehicles. Based on the results of the tender process.

### Background:

During the 2026 budget process, Council approved the purchase of a new Front Line Pumper for the North Kawartha Emergency Services. A tender package was advertised on the Township website and social media. Fire Truck manufactures were made aware that the North Kawartha Emergency Services were looking for bids on a Front line pumper, tender RFT-03-26

Two Bids were submitted:

- Battleshield Industries \$ 745,793.952
- City View Specialty Vehicles \$ 676,500.480

### Analysis:

In reviewing the tender's, City View Specialty Vehicles submitted the lowest bid. Having reviewed their submission they met all of the required specifications stated on the tender specification document with a delivery date of 365 days or less.

### Financial Implications:

During the 2026 Budget deliberations, Council approved the amount of \$700,000 for the purchase of a new pumper for Station #1.
