Preventing Violence and Harassment

It is our mutual responsibility to ensure that we create and maintain a harassment and violence free workplace and address violence and/or the threat of violence from all possible sources.

In cases of violence, not harassment, work refusal is a process under the Occupational Health and Safety Act.

Risk assessment

The CEO/Librarian (with worker involvement) assesses workplace violence hazards in all jobs, and in the workplace as a whole. They review risk assessments annually, as well as when new jobs are created, job descriptions are changed substantially or new workplaces are created.
