Policy

The North Kawartha Public Library will ensure that there is a well-planned set of programs for children and teens throughout the calendar year. Such programs shall be conducted with the intent of bringing children, teens and their parents into the library, promoting library services and fostering a love of reading.

Procedures

- 1. The Programming Coordinator and Technical Services and Programming Manager shall be responsible for overseeing the development, implementation and accountability of children's and teen's programming.
- 2. The requirements for children's and teen's programs will depend on the needs of the community. Examples of such programs might include:
 - maker spaces, traditional and technology related
 - story times for different ages with finger games, songs and crafts
 - summer reading activities
 - March Break, Pumpkin Contest, Gingerbread Building
 - class visits & Forest of Reading
 - puppet & magic shows
 - author visits
 - Public Library Week activities
 - teen book club and/or teen advisory group
 - movies
 - gaming, computer activities, computer programming & robotics
 - nature talks
- Programs for children and teens shall take into account the policies and procedures in place in the Library for adults.
